Selectmen's Meeting

Non Public meeting started at 6:00pm, ended at 6:25pm

Regular Meeting started at 7:00pm called to order by Jenniefer.

Two Timber Cuts signed by the Selectmen.

Email from Noah Hodgetts from New Hampshire Office of Strategic Initiatives-Division of Planning is requesting an electronic or hard copy of the town's current Zoning Ordinances, Subdivision Regulations and Master Plan per RSA 675:9. Will find copy's and mail to Noah Hodgetts.

Received two letters from Bruce Frazer. The first letter, stating that Bruce will be retiring from his regular duties working for the Town of Monroe on Sept. 29, 2019. The second letter, stating that Bruce will be resigning from the Board of Selectmen on October 29, 2019. Jessica Brusseau made a motion to accept both letters of resignation and seconded by Jennifer Boucher. Rocky as well as others attending the Selectmen's meeting thanked Bruce for all his hard work and dedication to the Town of Monroe. Bruce will be missed by many.

The Selectmen have retained Allstaff to help recruit a person for the Admin. Assistant job. This job will be a 40 hours a week with benefits.

Rocky was asking about the flushing of the fire hydrants and who is responsible. Bruce stated that Randy and Jim have been finding all the shut off valves and painting the roadside as to where they are.

Due to the fact that the hydrants haven't been flushed in many years, it's good to know where they are in case of a hydrant breakage. Rocky expressed that the Fire Dept. needs to step up and start flushing and testing the hydrants on a regular basis. Will contact Todd Webster and Russell Brown to attend a Selectmen's meeting either on 7/24/19 or 7/30/19 @ 7pm. Will advise Rocky as he would like to attend the meeting.

John Lang asking about people living in school type of a bus in two locations and that's not in the Town's Zoning regulations. The Selectmen will look into this.

Julie Hall is in as a Library Trustee. She has three people interested as being a Library Trustee until the Town Meeting in March and is recommending two. The Selectmen need to appoint that position and will be done in a non public meeting.

Selectmen gave Keith the following dates for Jamie Dow to come visit the Selectmen. July 24, 26, 30 or 31st.

P.J. has expressed his frustration about the street lights that are still out for the past 6 months on Coppermine and Plains Road. Suggested to call the PUC will is doesn't get fixed with another week.

Motion made to have Bill Lang fix the area in Harley View Drive before the paving begins by Black Top. Black Top will be paving the area in Harley View Drive for \$4,395.00 and the Library for \$3,354.00

Bruce reports that he's been with Randy and Jim regarding three different "Turnarounds". The first, being on Lang Road. Land owner is Denis Ward and he approves this. The Second is Smutty Hollow Road and Priscilla Nest is the owner and approves that. The third is on Stanton Road. Brian and Philip Mike Ward are the owners of this. Need to check with NH Municipal Association as to obtaining an easement for these 3 "turnarounds".

One, intent to excavate permit signed and one use of the Town Hall signed.

Need to contact Vermont Tennis Court about getting a new tennis net as the one there the cable is broken.

Need to present Selectmen with 10-15 water meters that need to be changed out at the next meeting.
