Absentee Ballots

If you are unable to get to the polls on the 5th, you can request an absentee ballot by contacting the Town Clerk's office. The deadline to request an absentee ballot by mail is 12pm the day before the election. The deadline to request in person is 5pm the day before the election.

In Person Voter Registration

If you plan on registering to vote on Election Day, see the Supervisors of the Checklist when you arrive at the town hall. Bring proof of citizenship, age, primary residence address (domicile), and identity. If you do not have this, you will need to complete an affidavit.

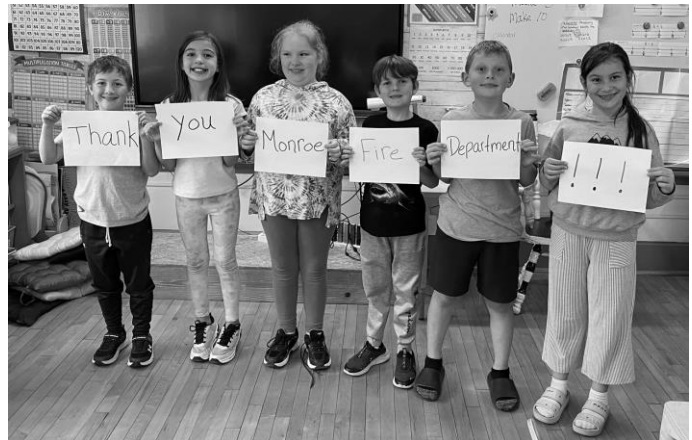
