FROM THE OFFICE OF THE SELECTMEN

Happy New Year! Town Meeting Day is right around the corner on March 11th with voting from 12-6 pm in the dining room of the town hall. Town Meeting will begin at 7 pm followed by School District Meeting.

- If interested in serving your town, watch for ads showing which positions are open and be sure to sign up with the Town Clerk’s office beginning Wednesday January 22, 2025 through Friday, January 31, 2025. Ends at 5 p.m.
- The Public Hearing for the Budget will be held Tuesday, February 11th beginning at 6 pm downstairs in the Town Hall. Town portion first; followed by the school.
- Skating rink is up and ready for use (red flag means the rink is not suitable for use)
- Plow trucks are on the roads. They have limited visibility so be sure to provide them with the room they need to make our roads safe for travel. Also remember, it is illegal to push snow across a roadway.
