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### SELECTMEN MEETING Minutes

April 21, 2026

Present: Oren Remick, Scott Powers, Brandon Millett

Oren moved to open the meeting at 7:00 p.m.

1. Approval of the April 14, 2026 Selectmen Meeting Minutes. Scott moved to approve the April 14, 2026 Selectmen Meeting Minutes and Oren seconded the motion. The minutes passed unanimously.
2. Public Input
  - a. Charles Hammer, president of the Monroe Bumper Humpers Club requested a letter of support for the Club to apply for a 2027 Recreational Trail Program grant to purchase a trail groomer and drag. The Selectmen approved writing a letter for the Club.
  - b. A concerned citizen stated there are problems with ORHV and dirt bikes speeding and driving too late at night. The citizen has called a meeting to discuss ways of managing the situation so that the roads do not get shut down. Meeting is scheduled for April 22, 2026 at 6:00 p.m. at the Town Hall.
3. Discussion items.
  - a. Diane stated the Brandon had found and suggested that a Granite State Clean Fleets grant for the new Highway Dump Truck be applied for. This grant is about reduction of diesel emissions and alternative fuel usage. After discussion, the Board decided it would be good to apply for this grant.
  - b. Franchise agreement with Charter. After discussion it was determined that Diane should check with the requestor to see why the renewal is requested at this time. Then a decision will be made on whether to negotiate the renewal through our lawyer or not..
  - c. Diane shared the road map for Timberwolf. She will provide it to the Highway Department when they show the route to Timberwolf. Also, Diane will find out about the additional dumpsters that Pete's Rubbish has rented in town.
  - d. A question was asked about being able to determine if things at Large Trash Day are coming from the citizens of the Town of Monroe. After discussion, the decision was made to request all

people dropping off items on Large Trsh Day bring a Driver's License to show they are from Monroe.

- e. REMINDER Local Emergency Operations Plan Update Schedule. The next meeting will be held at the Town Hall on Wednesday, April 29 from 6 – 8 pm Anyone interested in being involved can attend.
