#### SELECTMEN MEETING Minutes

September 3 2024

1. Approval of the August 27, 2024 Selectmen Meeting Minutes. Justin moved and John seconded to approve the August 27, 2024 minutes The motion carried.
2. Public
3. Discussion items.
  - a. The Selectmen requested updates on items for the Fall Festival. After a review of the plans, the Selectmen determined that the radar sign would be placed to help slow traffic in the area of the dance. Will also need people on alert to make sure the dance stays Family Friendly with NO ALCOHOL ALLOWED and NO SMOKING ON THE DANCE AREA. For the parade, will need to do road closures on Rt 135 for North and South as well as Plains Road. The 5k race will not include Route 135.

  - c. Pellets/Oil Prebuy – reviewing the prices provided to us. Reviewing the quantities needed – may not prebuy fuels this year. Justin added that the heating system at the Town Hall is being looked at on 9/23.
