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SELECTMEN MEETING Minutes

April 14, 2026

Present: Oren Remick, Scott Powers, Brandon Millett

Oren moved to open the meeting at 7:00 p.m.

1. Approval of the April 7, 2026 Selectmen Meeting Minutes. Scott moved to approve the April 7, 2026 Selectmen Meeting Minutes and Oren seconded the motion. The minutes passed unanimously.
2. Public Input
 - a. A concerned citizen asked if anything was happening in regard to recycling plastics/paper/cardboard. The Board noted that at this time there is nothing being done as there do not seem to be any outlets. The Board is willing to look into recycling again if an outlet can be found.
3. Discussion items.
 - a. Opening of the new Plow Truck Bids. A number of bids were received for the new Dump Truck. After reviewing the bids, the Board chose R.R. Charlebois Inc. for a Western Star chassis. No dump body or other equipment was selected at this time. Additional review of the bids will be done to select the other equipment. An overview of the bids received is attached to these minutes.
 - b. Sales Ratio letter with listing of house sales. The Board reviewed the listing. It was decided to send the listing to our assessor. More information will be known soon.
 - c. Diane noted that Larry Thomas has requested help from the Highway Dept to lift several cemetery monuments at the Village Cemetery. The Board agreed to have the Highway Dept help him.
 - d. Diane stated she had been contacted about dirt bikes and 4-wheelers racing on Plains Road. The question was brought up about whether dirt bikes are allowed on roads or not. Diane will review what can be found on the topic.
 - e. Diane stated Pete's Rubbish had contacted her about Large Trash Days. The Board decided that Timberwolf would be doing the last 2 Large Trash Day pickups. A question was asked if

Timberwolf would be doing the same route as Pete's. Suggestion was made to have the Highway Dept show them the roads onto which they can go. A listing of roads will be given to them showing which ones are public and which are private.

- f. The Board received an email abbot updating a Franchise Agreement with Charter Communications. After discussion, the decision was to contact our lawyer about this request.
 - g. REMINDER Local Emergency Operations Plan Update Schedule. The proposed meeting dates for the update of the Local Emergency Operations Plan were approved. The first meeting will be held at the Town Hall on Wednesday, April 15 from 6 – 8 pm Anyone interested in being involved can attend.
