### DISTRICT UPDATES

Lots of projects happened this summer at MCS! The old boilers and underground storage tank were removed and new energy efficient propane boilers were installed along with underground propane tanks. We had a new wall constructed in a large downstairs space and several counters removed, turning the space into two classrooms, so now every grade level has their own classroom and teacher. The old locker room spaces were renovated with the small walls being removed so those spaces are now more open and user friendly for student services. Several spaces were painted over the summer, including the lobby and ramp area. There was a backorder on the new LED lighting so that installation will be happening in the next few weeks. We are excited to have these improvements done for the new year.
